

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Golden State Soccer League

2008 Season

DEADLINE

Applications WITH fee payments must be submitted by league reps. Application packets must be received by May 16, 2008. Late team applications will be placed on a waiting list and will be charged a \$50 late fee.

APPLICATION FEES

U15-U19 \$250 U9-U14 \$60

Fees must be submitted with the application packets. Teams will not be processed unless fees have been paid. Fines assessed at the end of the previous playing season that were not covered by the home league's performance bond must be paid before applications will be accepted.

PERFORMANCE BOND

Each home league/club must provide a performance bond of \$200 for each ten (10) teams or portion of ten teams. Fines for the actions of any team from that home league will be drawn from the bond. Any unused portion will be returned to the league at the conclusion of the season.

WITHDRAWAL PENALTY

Clubs that withdraw teams after having been accepted will lose that team's entry fee.

AGE GROUP CLASSIFICATIONS

All teams are classified by the age of their oldest player.

Division 1: Teams selected by tryouts and composed of players in a one-year age group: U9, U10, U11, U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U19.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Open "GSSL Application". This is the on-line version of the application, follow instruction on the screen. When completed, print the paper application "GSSL Paper Application" and fill out as necessary. Mail with fees to –

Please take the time to fill out your roster information completely on both application versions – this is a tremendous help in justifying division requests! All applications must be completed and signed by the coach, the GSSL League Representative, the Home League President and Home League Coaching Director. The application must include at least 11, but not more than 18 registered players for U11 – U19 and at least 10, but more than 14 players for U9 and U10.
